Along the way, they'll experiment with various fabrics and even design their own patterns using fabric pens. By the end of the program, your child will know how to thread needles, sew buttons and zippers, cut and measure fabric, and use a sewing machine. Most importantly, they'll bring home projects they're proud of and new skills that inspire a lifetime of creativity!
